CALL FOR ABSTRACTS – Main Workshop

Workshop Dates: 1:00 PM, March 18 - 12:00 PM, March 20, 2026. (MDT)

Location: Salt Lake City Marriott City Center, 220 S State St, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111

Main Workshop Abstract Guidelines:

- The abstract should be no longer than 1 page single-spaced, including any tables or figures.
 - Maximum of 500 words of text
 - Font: Arial 11
- The topic should be related to primary immune deficiency, and may include case reports, clinical trial outcomes, preclinical studies, mechanistic studies.
- Data presented at other meetings is allowed, but data not presented previously will be prioritized.
- Include author list, affiliations, and indicate who is the presenting author by underlining the name.
- Indicate whether the presenting author is an underrepresented minority and/or a trainee

Selection, review process, travel support:

- Abstracts will be reviewed by the selection committee and results of review will be sent to authors in mid-January.
- The first 4 abstract submitters who are members of an underrepresented minority will be awarded a travel scholarship to support their participation at the meeting.
- The 4 best abstracts will be selected for **oral presentation** (10 min, 5 min of questions) on Thursday afternoon March 19. Travel for the abstract presenter will be supported by the PIDTC.
- Some abstracts (3-6) will be selected for a “**lightning**” talk to be held in the main meeting room on Wednesday March 18 (3-5 min each with 0-1 question) just before the poster session.
- All other authors will be informed whether their abstract was accepted for the meeting.
- Submitters of accepted abstracts can register for the meeting and access the PIDTC rate, space permitting. If the room block is full, options include staying at the hotel at the non-PIDTC rate or an alternate hotel nearby.

Optional poster presentation and/or inclusion in meeting materials:

- To enhance discussion of abstracts and provide more flexible options to disseminate the work within the PIDTC workshop community, we will provide accepted abstracts in the meeting materials as a pdf.
- Authors whose abstracts were accepted but not for oral presentation or lightning talk will be accepted for poster presentation.
- Dedicated time for poster viewing and discussion is set aside following the afternoon session on Wednesday, March 18. This session will begin with lightning poster talks followed by poster viewing in the poster hall. We will provide more details on options for poster display at the time of poster acceptance.
